The record of this matter and the Initial Decision of the Office of Administrative Law have been reviewed. No exceptions were filed by the parties.

Upon a careful and independent review of the record in this matter, the Commissioner concurs with the findings and conclusions of the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) in his Order of May 27, 2004, adopted by the ALJ as the Initial Decision in this matter. Such Order found that the Board had violated petitioner's tenure rights and, therefore, ordered petitioner reinstated to her former position of principal, together with any and all back pay, benefits and other emoluments. The Commissioner further concurs that the effect of correspondence from petitioner's counsel, dated June 30, 2004, September 8, 2004 and November 9, 2004, is to withdraw petitioner's claim to the position of Supervisor of Basic Skills, together with any and all back pay, benefits and other emoluments.<sup>1</sup>

Accordingly, the Initial Decision of the ALJ is adopted for the reasons expressed therein.

IT IS SO ORDERED.<sup>2</sup>
