SYNOPSIS

Petitioning custodian alleged the Board failed to pay his full salary without loss of sick time for work-related injury, pursuant to *N.J.S.A. 18A:30-2.1*.

The ALJ found that petitioner failed to file his petition within the 90-day period prescribed by *N.J.A.C. 6A:3-1.3(d)(1)*. The ALJ found that petitioner filed his petition approximately four and a half months after the Board's letter advising him that he had exhausted all his allotted sick days as of March 15 and would be on "non-pay status" until he returned to work. Petition was dismissed.

The Commissioner adopted the Initial Decision as his own.
