forwarded to the Commissioner pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:12-29 for final determination on the

Commission's recommended penalty, have been reviewed. Respondent filed an exception, asking

that she be accorded "leniency in the Commission's reprimand as an inexperience [sic] Board

Member who should have sought advice and/or been advised on how to appropriately execute

documentation filing [sic] on my own behalf." She did not appeal – pursuant to N.J.A.C. 6A:4 – the

Commission's underlying finding of violation.

Upon review, the Commissioner concurs with the penalty recommended by the

Commission. Respondent did not file her disclosure documents until five months after they were

due. This failure to timely honor an obligation placed upon board members by law resulted in

unnecessary expenditures of administrative and adjudicative resources at both State and local levels.

Accordingly, respondent is hereby reprimanded as a school official found to have

violated the School Ethics Act.
