Upon review, the Commissioner concurs with the penalty recommended by the

upon board members by law, since such failure has resulted in unnecessary expenditure of

administrative and adjudicative resources at both State and local levels.

Accordingly, respondent is hereby reprimanded as a school official found to have

violated the School Ethics Act.
