SYNOPSIS

Petitioner, a tenured teacher, sought restoration of sick time for injuries sustained in the course of employment, pursuant to *N.J.S.A.* 18A:30-2.1. The matter was placed on the inactive list pending settlement of the Worker's Compensation case. On October 2, 2009, counsel for petitioner advised that the matter had settled in Worker's Compensation Court and requested that the matter be dismissed.

The ALJ found that the issues in this matter have been resolved and the matter is therefore dismissed.

The Commissioner concurred with the ALJ, and adopted the Initial Decision of the OAL as the final decision in this matter.
