## **SYNOPSIS**

In May 2011, the petitioner filed a *pro se* residency appeal on behalf of her minor child, C.J., contending that the family was homeless and living with V.M.'s son in Orange. A hearing at the Office of Administrative Law (OAL) was scheduled for October 6, 2011, but petitioner failed to appear despite having received appropriate notice. She provided no explanation for her nonappearance.

Accordingly, the OAL returned the file to the Commissioner, and the petition was dismissed with prejudice.

The record for this matter, the Office of Administrative Law's (OAL) notice memorializing petitioner's failure to appear at the hearing on October 6, 2011, and a copy of the notification sent to the parties by the OAL on July 14, 2011, informing them of the date of hearing, have been reviewed. It is noted that the OAL hearing notice was sent to the address petitioner entered on her petition.

The Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) held the matter for several days after the hearing to give petitioner the opportunity to offer an explanation for her nonappearance - pursuant to *N.J.A.C.* 1:1-14.4(a). Having received no explanation from petitioner during the month following the hearing date, the ALJ returned the file to the Commissioner and sent petitioner a notice dated November 9, 2011 advising that she had thirteen days to provide the Commissioner with an explanation for her non-appearance.

There being no explanation filed with the Commissioner, this matter is no longer deemed to be a contested case before the Commissioner and is accordingly hereby dismissed with prejudice.
