The record of this matter and the decision of the School Ethics Commission (SEC) have

been reviewed. The SEC found that respondent violated N.J.S.A. 18A:12-24.1(e) and N.J.S.A. 18A:12-

24.1(i) when he approached the Chief School Administrator's subordinate employee to inquire whether

she would be interested in assuming the position of Chief School Administrator, even though that position

was not vacant. The SEC recommended a penalty of reprimand. The SEC's decision was forwarded

pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:12-29(c) for the Commissioner's final determination on the recommended

penalty. Respondent did not file exceptions to the recommended penalty, nor was the SEC's underlying

finding of a violation appealed to the Commissioner pursuant to N.J.A.C. 6A:4.

Upon review, the Commissioner concurs with the penalty recommended by the SEC.

Accordingly, the respondent is hereby reprimanded as a school official found to have violated the

School Ethics Act.
