DAVID WEIDEMOYER : ORDER OF REVOCATION

This matter was opened by the Board of Examiners by way of an Order to Show Cause issued to David Weidemoyer as to why his Teacher of Mathematics certificate should not be revoked. The Order to Show Cause was based on information provided to the State Board of Examiners by the Washington Township School District (Washington). Washington had advised that Weidemoyer, a district employee, had resigned from his tenured position after an investigation revealed that he had allegedly sent at least 92 lewd and inappropriate e-mails from school computers to two of his former students who were still students in the district. After the certification matter was transmitted to the Office of Administrative Law for hearing, Weidemoyer presented a settlement proposal to the Board in which he would voluntarily relinquish his certificate with the force and effect of a revocation. After reviewing the settlement proposal, at its meeting of April 29, 2010, the Board of Examiners voted to accept the proposal. Accordingly, on this 29th day of April 2010, David Weidemoyer's Teacher of Mathematics certificate is herby revoked.
