MATTHEW MARTIN : ORDER OF REVOCATION

At its meeting of December 9, 2010, the State Board of Examiners reviewed an affidavit that Matthew Martin had forwarded. After being charged with Endangering the Welfare of a Child, Luring or Enticing a Child and Official Misconduct, Martin forfeited his teaching certificates. Martin currently holds a Teacher of Mathematics Certificate of Eligibility With Advanced Standing, issued in September 1995, a Teacher of Mathematics certificate, issued in July 1996 and a Supervisor certificate, issued in January 2010.

Martin agreed to forfeit his certificates with the force and effect of a revocation and all attendant consequences in his affidavit to that effect to the New Jersey State Board of Examiners. At its meeting of December 9, 2010, the Board voted to accept Martin's relinquishment with the force and effect of a revocation pursuant to *N.J.A.C.* 6A:9-17.8.

Accordingly, on this 9th day of December 2010 it is therefore ORDERED that the revocation of Matthew Martin's Teacher of Mathematics Certificate of Eligibility With Advanced Standing and his Teacher of Mathematics and Supervisor certificates be effective immediately.
