DECISION

This matter was opened by the Board of Examiners by way of an Order to Show Cause issued to Anne Holmes as to why her Teacher of Elementary School certificate should not be revoked. The Order to Show Cause was based on information provided to the State Board of Examiners by the East Windsor Regional School District (EWRSD). The EWRSD had advised that Holmes, an elementary school teacher, had provided the district with a forged Supervisor certificate and a forged duplicate Supervisor certificate. Upon investigation, the Office of Licensure and Credentials in the Department of Education determined that Holmes had never been issued a Supervisor certificate or a duplicate. After the certification matter was transmitted to the Office of Administrative Law for hearing, Holmes presented a settlement proposal to the Board in which she would voluntarily relinquish her Teacher of Elementary School certificate with the force and effect of a revocation. After reviewing the settlement proposal, at its meeting of January 7, 2010, the Board of Examiners voted to accept the proposal. Accordingly, on this 7th day of January 2010, Anne Holmes' Teacher of Elementary School certificate is hereby revoked.
