IN THE MATTER OF NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION THE CERTIFICATES OF STATE BOARD OF EXAMINERS DAVID SINGER ORDER OF REVOCATION DOCKET NO. 0910-192 This matter was opened by the Board of Examiners by way of an Order to Show Cause issued to David Singer as to why his Teacher of Elementary School certificate, issued in July 1971 and his School Social Worker certificate, issued in March 1983 should not be revoked. The Order to Show Cause was based on information provided to the State Board of Examiners by the Freehold Township School District (Freehold). Freehold advised that it had removed Singer from its substitute list after it discovered that he had been forced to surrender permanently his license to practice professional counseling and rehabilitation counseling in New Jersey after a client alleged that he had engaged in professional and sexual misconduct. Freehold also advised that Singer was in violation of the surrender order by continuing to conduct therapy despite the relinquishment of his professional license. After the teaching certification matter was transmitted to the Office of Administrative Law for hearing, Singer presented a

settlement proposal to the Board in which he would voluntarily relinquish his certificates with the force

and effect of a revocation. After reviewing the settlement proposal, at its meeting of October 28, 2010,

the Board of Examiners voted to accept the proposal. Accordingly, on this 28th day of October 2010,

David Singer's Teacher of Elementary School and School Social Worker certificates are hereby revoked.
