At its meeting of June 16, 2011, the State Board of Examiners reviewed an affidavit that George Friery, Jr. had submitted. After pleading guilty to Endangering the Welfare of Children, Friery was court-ordered to forfeit his teaching certificates. Friery currently holds a Teacher of Spanish Certificate of Eligibility, issued in September 1992 and a Teacher of Spanish certificate, issued in March 1999.

Friery agreed to forfeit his certificates with the force and effect of a revocation and all attendant consequences in his affidavit to that effect to the New Jersey State Board of Examiners. At its meeting of June 16, 2011, the Board voted to accept Friery's relinquishment with the force and effect of a revocation pursuant to *N.J.A.C.* 6A:9-17.8.

Accordingly, on this 16th day of June 2011 it is therefore ORDERED that the revocation of George Friery Jr.'s Teacher of Spanish Certificate of Eligibility and Teacher of Spanish certificate be effective immediately.
