This matter was opened by the Board of Examiners (Board) by way of an Order to Show Cause issued to Bienvenido Cueto as to why his teaching certificates should not be revoked or suspended. Cueto currently holds a Teacher of Business: Finance/Economics/Law Certificate of Eligibility, issued in August 2006, a School Business Administrator Certificate of Eligibility, issued in November 2008 and a Teacher of Business: Finance/Economics/Law certificate, issued in December 2008. Pursuant to *N.J.A.C.* 6A:9-17.4, the Hoboken School District had notified the Board that Cueto had resigned from his tenured position after being suspended for inappropriate communications with a student. After the teaching certification matter was transmitted to the Office of Administrative Law for hearing, Cueto presented a settlement proposal to the Board in which his certificates would be suspended for two years. After reviewing the settlement proposal, at its meeting of April 2, 2012, the Board voted to accept the proposal. Accordingly, on this 2nd day of April 2012, Bienvenido Cueto's Teacher of Business: Finance/Economics/Law Certificate of Eligibility, School Business Administrator Certificate of Eligibility and Teacher of Business: Finance/Economics/Law certificate are hereby SUSPENDED for a period of two years effective immediately.
