At its meeting of June 21, 2012, the State Board of Examiners reviewed an affidavit that Philip Roth had submitted. In 2006, Roth's New York teaching certificates were revoked as a result of his guilty plea in 1984 to Attempted Sexual Assault, 1st degree and his failure to disclose that information on a fingerprint referral from the New York City Board of Education. In New Jersey, Roth currently holds a Teacher of General Business certificate, issued in September 1970 and a Principal certificate, issued in June 1974.

Roth agreed to relinquish his certificates with the force and effect of a revocation and all attendant consequences in his affidavit to that effect to the New Jersey State Board of Examiners. At its meeting of June 21, 2012, the Board voted to accept Roth's relinquishment with the force and effect of a revocation pursuant to *N.J.A.C.* 6A:9-17.8.

Accordingly, on this 21st day of June 2012 it is therefore ORDERED that Philip Roth's Teacher of General Business and Principal certificates be REVOKED effective immediately.
