DARNELL M. LEWIS : ORDER OF REVOCATION

At its meeting of May 21, 2015, the New Jersey State Board of Examiners (Board) reviewed an affidavit that the Monmouth County Prosecutor's Office had submitted regarding Darnell M. Lewis. Lewis pled guilty to Impairing or Debauching the Morals of a Child. Lewis was sentenced to 364 days incarceration in the Monmouth County Correctional facility, ordered to register pursuant to Megan's Law, subject to parole supervision for life and fined. He was also ordered to forfeit his public employment. Lewis currently holds a Substitute Credential, which expires in July 2018.

Lewis agreed to relinquish his credential with the force and effect of a revocation and all attendant consequences in his affidavit to that effect to the Board. At its meeting of May 21, 2015, the Board voted to accept Lewis's relinquishment with the force and effect of a revocation pursuant to *N.J.A.C.* 6A:9B-4.8.

Accordingly, on this 21st day of May 2015 it is therefore ORDERED that Darnell M. Lewis' Substitute Credential be revoked effective immediately.
