This matter was opened by the Board of Examiners (Board) by way of an Order to Show Cause issued to Joseph Oliverie as to why his teaching certificate should not be suspended. Oliverie currently holds a Teacher of Elementary School certificate, issued in June 1983. After the teaching certification matter was transmitted to the Office of Administrative Law for hearing, Oliverie presented a proposal to the Board in which he would agree to a one-year suspension of his certificate. Oliverie did not admit to the allegations in the Order to Show Cause. After reviewing the proposal, at its meeting of October 30, 2015, the Board voted to accept it. Accordingly, on this 30th day of October 2015, Joseph Oliverie's Teacher of Elementary School certificate is hereby SUSPENDED for a period of one year, effective immediately. It is further ORDERED that Oliverie return the above-mentioned suspended certificate to the Secretary of the State Board of Examiners, Office of Certification and Induction, P.O. Box 500, Trenton, NJ 08625-0500 within 30 days of the effective date of the suspension.
