This matter was opened by the Board of Examiners (Board) by way of an Order to Show Cause issued to Olabisi Dabiri-Okoya as to why her teaching certificates should not be revoked. Dabiri-Okoya currently holds two Substitute Credentials, one which expires in January 2016 and one which expires in January 2020. After the teaching certification matter was transmitted to the Office of Administrative Law for hearing, Dabiri-Okoya presented a proposal to the Board in which she would agree to the relinquishment of her credentials with the force and effect of a revocation pursuant to *N.J.A.C.* 6A:9B-4.7. Dabiri-Okoya did not admit or concede the truth of the allegations in the Order to Show Cause. After reviewing the proposal, at its meeting of December 9, 2016, the Board voted to accept it. Accordingly, on this 9th day of December 2016, Olabisi Dabiri-Okoya's two Substitute Credentials are hereby REVOKED, effective immediately. It is further ORDERED that Dabiri-Okoya return the above-mentioned credentials to the Secretary of the State Board of Examiners, Office of Certification and Induction, P.O. Box 500, Trenton, NJ 08625-0500 within 30 days of the mailing date of the decision.
