This matter was opened by the Board of Examiners (Board) by way of an Order to Show Cause issued to Jimmie E. Warren as to why his teaching certificates should not be revoked. Warren currently holds a Principal Certificate of Eligibility, issued in August 2004, a Principal certificate, issued in August 2006 and a School Administrator Certificate of Eligibility, issued in January 2010. After the teaching certification matter was transmitted to the Office of Administrative Law for hearing, Warren presented a proposal to the Board in which he would agree to the relinquishment of his certificates with the force and effect of a revocation pursuant to *N.J.A.C.* 6A:9B-4.8. Warren did not admit or concede the truth of the allegations in the Order to Show Cause. After reviewing the proposal, at its meeting of January 21, 2016, the Board voted to accept it. Accordingly, on this 21st day of January 2016, Jimmie E. Warren's Principal and School Administrator Certificates of Eligibility and his Principal certificate are hereby REVOKED, effective immediately. It is further ORDERED that Warren return the above-mentioned certificates to the Secretary of the State Board of Examiners, Office of Certification and Induction, P.O. Box 500, Trenton, NJ 08625-0500 within 30 days of the mailing date of the decision.
