RONALD KLIMIK : ORDER OF SUSPENSION

This matter was opened by the Board of Examiners (Board) by way of an Order to Show Cause issued to Ronald Klimik as to why his teaching certificates should not be revoked. Klimik currently holds a Teacher of Elementary School certificate, issued in February 1985, a Teacher of Nursery School certificate issued in October 1985 and a Teacher of the Handicapped certificate, issued in June 1987. After the teaching certification matter was transmitted to the Office of Administrative Law for hearing, Klimik presented a proposal to the Board in which he would agree to a twenty-year suspension of his certificates. Klimik did not admit or concede the truth of the allegations in the Order to Show Cause. After reviewing the proposal, at its meeting of March 3, 2016, the Board voted to accept it. Accordingly, on this 3rd day of March 2016, Ronald Klimik's Teacher of Elementary School, Teacher of Nursery School and Teacher of the Handicapped certificates are hereby SUSPENDED for a period of twenty years, effective immediately. It is further ORDERED that Klimik return the above-mentioned suspended certificates to the Secretary of the State Board of Examiners, Office of Certification and Induction, P.O. Box 500, Trenton, NJ 08625-0500 within 30 days of the effective date of the suspension.
