ANNMARIE GUENTHER : ORDER OF SUSPENSION

This matter was opened by the Board of Examiners (Board) by way of an Order to Show Cause issued to Annmarie Guenther as to why her teaching certificates should not be suspended. Guenther currently holds a Teacher of Music certificate, issued in July 1982, a Teacher of Elementary School certificate, issued in November 1991, a Principal Certificate of Eligibility, issued in February 2006 and a Supervisor certificate, issued in February 2006. After the teaching certification matter was transmitted to the Office of Administrative Law for hearing, Guenther presented a proposal to the Board in which she would agree to a two-month suspension of her Supervisor certificate, effective July 1, 2017 through August 31, 2017. Guenther did not admit or concede the truth of the allegations in the Order to Show Cause. After reviewing the proposal, at its meeting of November 1, 2016, the Board voted to accept it. Accordingly, on this 1st day of November 2016, Annmarie Guenther's Supervisor certificate is hereby SUSPENDED for a period of two months, effective July 1, 2017. It is further ORDERED that Guenther return the above-mentioned suspended certificates to the Secretary of the State Board of Examiners, Office of Certification and Induction, P.O. Box 500, Trenton, NJ 08625-0500 within 30 days of the effective date of the suspension.
