This matter was opened by the Board of Examiners (Board) by way of an Order to Show Cause issued to Daniel Laws as to why his teaching certificates should not be revoked. Laws currently holds a Teacher of Carpentry Certificate of Eligibility, issued in August 2006 and a Teacher of Carpentry certificate, issued in November 2007. After the teaching certification matter was transmitted to the Office of Administrative Law for hearing, Laws presented a proposal to the Board in which he would agree to the relinquishment of his certificates with the force and effect of a revocation pursuant to *N.J.A.C.* 6A:9B-4.7. Laws did not admit or concede the truth of the allegations in the Order to Show Cause. After reviewing the proposal, at its meeting of September 16, 2016, the Board voted to accept it. Accordingly, on this 16th day of September 2016, Daniel Laws' Teacher of Carpentry Certificate of Eligibility and Teacher of Carpentry certificate are hereby REVOKED, effective immediately. It is further ORDERED that Laws return the above-mentioned certificates to the Secretary of the State Board of Examiners, Office of Certification and Induction, P.O. Box 500, Trenton, NJ 08625-0500
