At its meeting of April 6, 2017, the New Jersey State Board of Examiners (Board) reviewed an affidavit that the Gloucester County Prosecutor's Office had submitted regarding Dshawn M. Haines. On or about February 10, 2017, Haines pled guilty to Endangering the Welfare of a Child (3rd degree). As a result of his conviction, Haines was also disqualified from public employment pursuant to *N.J.S.A.* 18A:6-7.1 *et seq.* Haines currently holds a Substitute Credential, which expires in July 2021.

Haines agreed to relinquish his credential with the force and effect of a revocation and all attendant consequences in his affidavit to that effect to the Board. At its meeting of April 6, 2017, the Board voted to accept Haines's relinquishment with the force and effect of a revocation pursuant to *N.J.A.C.* 6A:9B-4.7.

Accordingly, on this 6th day of April 2017 it is therefore ORDERED that Dshawn M. Haines's Substitute Credential be revoked, effective immediately.
