JENYE V. KNOX : ORDER OF SUSPENSION

This matter was opened by the Board of Examiners (Board) by way of an Order to Show Cause issued to Jenye V. Knox as to why her teaching certificates should not be revoked. Knox currently holds Teacher of Elementary School, Teacher of Nursery School and Teacher of the Handicapped certificates, all issued in February 1990. After the teaching certification matter was transmitted to the Office of Administrative Law for hearing, Knox presented a proposal to the Board in which she would agree to a three-year suspension of her certificates. Knox did not admit or concede the truth of the allegations in the Order to Show Cause. After reviewing the proposal, at its meeting of December 8, 2017, the Board voted to accept it. Accordingly, on this 8th day of December 2017, Jenye V. Knox's Teacher of Elementary School, Teacher of Nursery School and Teacher of the Handicapped certificates are hereby SUSPENDED for three years, effective immediately. It is further ORDERED that Knox return the above-mentioned certificates to the Secretary of the State Board of Examiners, Office of Certification and Induction, P.O. Box 500, Trenton, NJ 08625-0500 within 30 days of the mailing date of the decision.
