DAVID H. LIGHT : ORDER OF REVOCATION

At its meeting of December 8, 2017, the New Jersey State Board of Examiners (Board) reviewed an affidavit that the Camden County Prosecutor's Office had forwarded regarding David H. Light. On June 20, 2017, Light pled guilty to Endangering-Abuse/Neglect of a Child. Light currently holds a Teacher of Elementary School in Grades K-6 Certificate of Eligibility, issued in April 2013, a Teacher of Elementary School in Grades K-6 Certificate of Eligibility with Advanced Standing, issued in May 2013, a Teacher of Elementary School with Subject Matter Specialization: Mathematics in Grades 5-8 Certificate of Eligibility with Advanced Standing, issued in January 2014, a Teacher of Elementary School in Grades K-6 certificate, issued in May 2015 and a Teacher of Elementary School with Subject Matter Specialization: Mathematics in Grades 5-8 certificate, issued in May 2015.

Light agreed to relinquish his certificates with the force and effect of a revocation and all attendant consequences in his affidavit to that effect to the Board. At its meeting of December 8, 2017, the Board voted to accept Light's relinquishment with the force and effect of a revocation pursuant to *N.J.A.C. 6A:9B-4.7*.

Accordingly, on this 8th day of December 2017, it is therefore ORDERED that David H. Light's Teacher of Elementary School in Grades K-6 Certificate of Eligibility, Teacher of Elementary School in Grades K-6 and Teacher of Elementary School with Subject Matter Specialization: Mathematics in Grades 5-8 Certificates of Eligibility with Advanced Standing, and his Teacher of Elementary School in Grades K-6 and Teacher of Elementary School with

Subject Matter Specialization: Mathematics in Grades 5-8 certificates are hereby revoked, effective immediately.
