At its meeting of June 15, 2017, the New Jersey State Board of Examiners (Board) reviewed an affidavit that the Mercer County Prosecutor's Office had submitted regarding Elizandra Martinez. On April 18, 2017, Martinez pled guilty to Criminal Sexual Contact (4<sup>th</sup> degree). As a condition of her plea, Martinez forfeited her teaching credential. Martinez currently holds a Substitute Credential, which expires in April 2021.

Martinez agreed to relinquish her credential with the force and effect of a revocation and all attendant consequences in her affidavit to that effect to the Board. At its meeting of June 15, 2017, the Board voted to accept Martinez's relinquishment with the force and effect of a revocation pursuant to *N.J.A.C.* 6A:9B-4.7.

Accordingly, on this 15th day of June 2017, it is therefore ORDERED that Elizandra Martinez's Substitute Credential be revoked, effective immediately.
