LUANNE MACRI : ORDER OF SUSPENSION

This matter was opened by the Board of Examiners (Board) by way of two Orders to Show Cause issued to Luanne Macri as to why her teaching certificates should not be revoked. Macri currently holds a Teacher of Elementary School Certificate of Eligibility, issued in June 1993, a Teacher of Elementary School certificate, issued in August 1995, a Supervisor certificate, issued in August 2001 and a Principal certificate, issued in July 2005. After the teaching certification matters were transmitted to the Office of Administrative Law for hearing, Macri presented a proposal to the Board in which she would agree to a two-year suspension of her certificates. Macri did not admit or concede the truth of the allegations in the Orders to Show Cause. After reviewing the proposal, at its meeting of November 1, 2017, the Board voted to accept it. Accordingly, on this 1st day of November 2017, Luanne Macri's Teacher of Elementary School Certificate of Eligibility and her Teacher of Elementary School, Supervisor and Principal certificates are hereby SUSPENDED for two years, effective immediately. It is further ORDERED that Macri return the above-mentioned certificates to the Secretary of the State Board of Examiners, Office of Certification and Induction, P.O. Box 500, Trenton, NJ 08625-0500 within 30 days of the mailing date of the decision.
