DAVID C. HEYMAN ORDER OF SUSPENSION

This matter was opened by the Board of Examiners (Board) by way of an Order to Show Cause issued to David C. Heyman as to why his teaching certificates should not be revoked. Heyman currently holds a Teacher of Elementary Grades K-8 Certificate of Eligibility, Teacher of Social Studies Certificate of Eligibility, and Teacher of Social Studies Certificate.

After the matter was transmitted to the Office of Administrative Law for hearing, Heyman presented a proposal to the Board in which he agreed to a two (2) year suspension of his certificates, commencing on April 3, 2020. Haddad did not admit or concede the truth of the allegations in the Order to Show Cause. After reviewing the proposal, at its meeting of May 14, 2020, the Board voted to accept it.

Accordingly, on this 14th day of May 2020, it is therefore ordered that David C. Heyman's Teacher of Elementary Grades K-8 Certificate of Eligibility, Teacher of Social Studies Certificate of Eligibility, and Teacher of Social Studies Certificate are hereby suspended for a period of two (2) years, commencing on April 3, 2020. It is further ORDERED that Heyman return the above-mentioned certificates to the Secretary of the State Board of Examiners, Office of Certification and Induction, P.O. Box 500, Trenton, NJ 08625-0500 within 30 days of the mailing date of the decision.
