After a thorough review of the record, including the transcripts of the hearing held in the Office of Administrative Law in this matter, we affirm the decision of the State Board of Examiners for the reasons expressed therein. We agree that the appellant's conduct as demonstrated in the record implicates her fitness to serve as a teacher and warrants revocation of her instructional certification as a Teacher of Social Studies, Teacher of Elementary School and Teacher of the Handicapped.¹ <u>See I/M/O the</u> <u>Revocation of the Certificates of Hattie Black by the State Board of Examiners,</u> Docket #A-2635-03T1 (App. Div. 2005).

¹ The Board of Examiners noted that the appellant had obtained a Substance Awareness Coordinator Certificate of Eligibility and a Learning Disabilities Teacher Consultant certification subsequent to issuance of the Order to Show Cause in this matter, and it reserved the right to take future action against those certificates.
