On May 3, 2006, the State Board of Education affirmed the decision of the State Board of Examiners to revoke the teaching certificate of the appellant, Stephen Fox, a teaching staff member, who acknowledged that he had kissed on the lips a male student who had come to him for guidance. The State Board concurred with the Board of Examiners that the appellant's behavior demonstrated his unfitness to teach and that revocation of his certification was the appropriate penalty under the circumstances.

On August 29, 2007, the Appellate Division, concluding that the appellant was entitled to present evidence in mitigation of the revocation sanction, remanded this

matter to the State Board of Education for referral to the Office of Administrative Law for a hearing limited to the issue of the appropriate sanction.

In view of the Court's decision, we remand this matter to the State Board of Examiners for transmittal to the Office of Administrative Law for such proceedings as may be required to fulfill the terms of the Court's decision. We do not retain jurisdiction.
