The New Jersey Department of Education will advance The Road Forward initiative through a multipronged approach resulting in a compendium of resources for Local Education Agencies (LEAs) to use for the 2021-2022 school year.



Purpose

- Collaborate with stakeholders to enhance our responsiveness to LEAs' needs as they navigate reopening for the 2021-2022 school year.
- Four themes guide the engagement strategy:
 - -operations,
 - -insecurities,
 - -learning acceleration, and
 - -financial considerations.
- The result will be a LEA Reopening Self Assessment Checklist for 2021-2022 school year.



Guiding Questions

- What social-emotional and other non-academic supports do our students need to succeed during 2021-2022 school year?
- What academic supports do our students need to succeed during the 2021-2022 school year?
- What can the NJDOE do to support educators and LEAs during the 2021-2022 school year?



Participant Overview

- 130 individuals participated in working groups.
- 16 associations represented in working groups.
- 16 individual themed sessions conducted.
- Participants self-selected into the four themes:
 - -Session 1 identified priorities by theme.
 - -Session 2 focused on the development of the LEA Reopening Checklist.
