**Complaint Disposition:** The Complainant asserts a denial of access to records requested on May 22, 2007, September 11, 2007, September 13, 2007 and October 18, 2007. However, the GRC does not have jurisdiction over records request made of the Superior Court, as it falls under the Judicial Branch of government.

**Applicable OPRA Provision:** "The council shall not have jurisdiction over the Judicial or Legislative Branches of State Government or any agency, officer, or employee of those branches." <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 47:1A-7.g.

This is the final administrative determination in this matter. Any further review should be pursued in the Appellate Division of the Superior Court of New Jersey within forty-five (45) days.
