The form shall provide space for the name, address, and phone number of the requestor and a brief description of the government record sought..." N.J.S.A. 47:1A-5.f.

OPRA also provides that:

"[a] request for access to a government record shall be in writing and hand-delivered, mailed, transmitted electronically, or otherwise conveyed to the appropriate custodian..." N.J.S.A. 47:1A-5.g.

This is the final administrative determination in this matter. Any further review should be pursued in the Appellate Division of the Superior Court of New Jersey within forty-five (45) days.
