Complaint Disposition: The Complainant has affirmatively asserted on the Denial of Access Complaint form that he/she has also instituted an action in Superior Court regarding the denial of access at issue in the complaint also filed with the Government Records Council.

Applicable OPRA Provision: "A person who is denied access to a government record by the custodian of the record, at the option of the requestor, may: institute a proceeding to challenge the custodian's decision by filing an action in Superior Court ...; or in lieu of filing an action in Superior Court, file a complaint with the Government Records Council ..." (Emphasis added). N.J.S.A. 47:1A-6.

This is the final administrative determination in this matter. Any further review should be pursued in the Appellate Division of the Superior Court of New Jersey within forty-five (45) days.
