

## NEW JERSEY GOVERNMENT RECORDS COUNCIL Administrative Complaint Disposition – Request Not Within the Council's Jurisdiction to Adjudicate

**Complaint Disposition:** The Complainant asserts a denial of access to records requested on March 29, 2008. However, the GRC does not have jurisdiction over records request made of the Superior Court-Essex County, as it falls under the Judicial Branch of government.

**Applicable OPRA Provision:** "The council shall not have jurisdiction over the Judicial or Legislative Branches of State Government or any agency, officer, or employee of those branches." <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 47:1A-7.g.

This is the final administrative determination in this matter. Any further review should be pursued in the Appellate Division of the Superior Court of New Jersey within forty-five (45) days.
