## Administrative Complaint Disposition – Request Not Within Council's Jurisdiction to Adjudicate (Request Made to Judiciary)

**Date of Request:** November 30, 2009 **Date of Complaint:** March 22, 2010<sup>1</sup>

**Complaint Disposition:** The Complainant asserts a denial of access to records requested on November 30, 2009. However, the GRC does not have jurisdiction over records request made of the Superior Court - Essex Vicinage, as it falls under the Judicial Branch of government.

**Applicable OPRA Provision:** OPRA states that:

"The council shall not have jurisdiction over the Judicial or Legislative Branches of State Government or any agency, officer, or employee of those branches." N.J.S.A. 47:1A-7.g.

This is the final administrative determination in this matter. Any further review should be pursued in the Appellate Division of the Superior Court of New Jersey within forty-five (45) days.
