At the February 24, 2011 public meeting, the Government Records Council ("Council") considered the February 15, 2011 Findings and Recommendations of the Executive Director and all related documentation submitted by the parties. The Council voted unanimously to adopt the entirety of said findings and recommendations. The Council, therefore, finds that this case should be dismissed based on Judge Dana's December 3, 2008 Judgment.

#### **December 3, 2008**

Judgment of the Honorable Craig U. Dana, J.M.C., Joint Municipal Court of the Townships of Green, Fredon, Hampton and the Borough of Andover. Judge Dana issues a Judgment of Conviction for harassment and trespass violations prohibiting Thomas Caggiano from having any contact with any present or former employee or official of the Borough of Stanhope except that Mr. Caggiano may mail his tax and utility payments to the Borough and he may call 911 if he has an emergency.

#### June 29, 2010

#### **January 3, 2011**

Denial of Access Complaint filed with the Government Records Council ("GRC") attaching the Complainant's letter request dated June 29, 2010.
