Complaint Disposition: The Complainant stated in his Denial of Access Complaint that his sole argument is that the City of Trenton's OPRA request form is not complaint with OPRA. The Complainant does not assert that he was denied access to any record(s) pursuant to his June 10, 2015, OPRA request.

Applicable OPRA Provision: OPRA provides that:

"[t]he Government Records Council shall . . . receive, hear, review and adjudicate a complaint filed by any person *concerning a denial of access to a government record by a record custodian* . . ." N.J.S.A. 47:1A-7(b) (emphasis added).

This is the final administrative determination in this matter. Any further review should be pursued in the Appellate Division of the Superior Court of New Jersey within forty-five (45) days.
