

NEW JERSEY GOVERNMENT RECORDS COUNCIL Administrative Complaint Disposition – Not a Valid OPRA Request

Complaint Disposition: On March 23, 2017, the Complainant submitted a "Consent for Release of Information" form to Charles Ellis, Administrator, at the Mercer County Correction Facility ("MCCF"). This form did not cite to OPRA. Thus, the correspondence did not constitute a valid OPRA request. The GRC's authority is limited to adjudicating denial of access complaints based on valid OPRA requests. *See also* <u>Bragg v. Mercer Cnty. Corr. Ctr.</u>, GRC Complaint No. 2015-396 (May 2016).

Applicable OPRA Provision: "A request for access to a government record shall be in writing and hand-delivered, mailed, transmitted electronically, or otherwise conveyed to the appropriate custodian." <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 47:1A- 5(g).

"The council shall make a determination as to whether the complaint is within its jurisdiction or frivolous or *without any reasonable factual basis.*" <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 47:1A-7(e) (emphasis added).

This is the final administrative determination in this matter. Any further review should be pursued in the Appellate Division of the Superior Court of New Jersey within forty-five (45) days.
