Case Disposition: On May 8, 2006, the New Jersey Department of Corrections received the Complainant's OPRA request for the annual report of the five (5) year recidivism data for ADTC releases as per NJSA 2C:47-9 for each year from 1997-2006.

On May 15, 2007, the Custodian denied the Complainant's request in writing stating that no records responsive to the request exist. The Custodian also certified again on January 8, 2007 that no records responsive to this request exist.

Type of Administrative Disposition: No records responsive to the request.

Applicable OPRA Provision: N.J.S.A. 47:1A-1.1. states that a ""[g]overnment record' or 'record' means any paper, written or printed book, document, drawing, map, plan, photograph, microfilm, data processed or image processed document, information stored or maintained electronically or by sound-recording or in a similar device, or any copy thereof, that has been made, maintained or kept on file ... or that has been or received in the course of his or its official business by any such officer, commission, agency, or authority of the State or of any political subdivision thereof, including subordinate boards thereof..." (Emphasis added.)

This is the final administrative determination in this matter. Any further review should be pursued in the Appellate Division of the Superior Court of New Jersey within forty-five (45) days.
