Calendar Year 2018 **Report of Documented Charity Care** Office of Health Care Financing 2020

Trenton, New Jersey

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Executive Summary

Acute care hospitals in the State of New Jersey (NJ) are required by state law to provide all necessary care to patients regardless of ability to pay. Charity Care is free or reduced charge care that is provided to patients who receive their inpatient and outpatient services at acute care hospitals throughout the state. To help offset the costs to hospitals of uncompensated care delivered to low-income uninsured patients, the state provides subsidies through the New Jersey Hospital Care Payment Assistance Program (Charity Care Program). The source of funding for hospital care payment assistance is through the Health Care Subsidy Fund administered under N.J.S.A.26:2H-18.58.

Charity care subsidies to hospitals are based on the charity care formula and are not reimbursement for individual claims. Hospitals submit charity care claims to the state, which are then priced at the Medicaid payment rate. The Department of Health (DOH) audits these submitted charity care claims on a quarterly basis. The total value of a year's audited charity claims is referred to as Documented Charity Care (DCC). The DCC is one of the factors used in the charity care subsidy formula to calculate charity care subsidies to hospitals.

This report summarizes DCC data based on the Medicaid payment rate for all eligible New Jersey hospitals for each facility's calendar year (CY) ending in 2018 (71 hospitals in total). New Jersey hospitals reported \$487.4 million in DCC for CY 2018. The inpatient portion totaled \$251.8 million (51.7%) and the outpatient portion totaled \$235.6 million (48.3%). Total DCC increased by 1.2% for a total of \$5.8 million from CY 2017. The decreasing trend through CY 2016 was attributed to the effects of expansion of the Medicaid (NJ FamilyCare) program originally effective January 1, 2014. Explanation of the trend reversal demonstrating increases in CY 2017 and CY 2018 DCC is unclear, though it may be related to changes in federal policy related to the Affordable Care Act (ACA) beginning in 2017.

Individual Hospitals: Fourteen hospitals each reported over \$10 million in documented charity care in CY 2018, compared to thirteen in CY 2017. These 14 hospitals accounted for 63.9% of all DCC statewide, compared to 13 hospitals accounting for 60.0% in CY 2017. Thirty-nine hospitals reported an increase in DCC compared to forty-one in CY 2017. Thirty-two hospitals reported a decrease in DCC compared to thirty-one in CY 2017. University Hospital reported the highest dollar amount of DCC in CY 2018 of \$61.1 million (compared to \$60.7 million in CY 2017, a 0.6% increase) and accounted for 12.5% of total DCC for the state. CarePoint Health Christ Hospital reported the largest dollar decrease of DCC in CY 2018 of \$2.3 million (18.0% for that hospital). Raritan Bay Medical Center – Perth Amboy reported the second largest dollar decrease in CY 2018 of \$2.1 million (54.2% for that hospital). Wide variation was seen in CY 2018 DCC among hospitals ranging from \$219,050 to \$61.1 million. Note that one closed hospital (Virtua – Berlin) reported a trickle of claim activity (\$7,411) in CY 2018 and is necessarily included in the DCC totals, though it is not included as appropriate in the analysis.

<u>Systems</u>: RWJBarnabas Health reported the highest dollar amount of charity care for a health system in CY 2018 of \$79.8 million and accounted for 16.4% of total DCC for the state, with Hackensack Meridian Health reporting the second highest of \$54.3 million and 11.1% of the DCC statewide. RWJBarnabas reported the largest dollar increase of charity care for a health system in CY 2018 of \$4.1 million. Trinity Health reported the largest dollar decrease of charity care for a

health system in CY 2018 of \$2.9 million, from a CY 2017 total of \$12.0 million. It is noteworthy that the highest dollar increase of charity care overall is due to all other hospitals combined who are not system affiliated for a total increase of \$6.0 million.

Health systems identified in this report correspond to the system membership as of December 31, 2018 for all time periods reported. RWJBarnabas and Hackensack Meridian Health System mergers are now reflected on a consolidated basis in this report.

<u>Regions</u>: Hospitals in selected groupings reported higher average DCC than hospitals in other areas. New Jersey hospitals in the urban settings of Trenton/Mercer, Newark, Hudson, Camden, and Passaic/Paterson reported an average DCC per hospital of \$12.8 million compared to all other hospitals average DCC of \$4.2 million. At the county level, Essex and Union Counties experienced the largest increase in DCC of \$3.1 million (3.1%) and \$3.1 million (8.7%) respectively, and Warren County experienced the smallest increase in DCC of \$161,3600 (12.3%). Middlesex and Hudson Counties had the largest decreases in DCC of \$4.7 million (9.0%) and \$2.1 million (4.2%) respectively, and Salem County experienced the smallest decrease in DCC of \$123,611 (15.1%). Atlantic, Cape May, Cumberland, Hudson, Hunterdon, Middlesex, Monmouth, Salem, and Sussex Counties were the only counties that experienced a decrease in DCC, \$9.8 million (126.6%), cumulative, between CY 2018 and CY 2017.

Background

The New Jersey Hospital Care Payment Assistance Program, commonly referred to as the NJ Charity Care Program, is a state program designed to subsidize New Jersey hospitals for the charitable care they provide. Many states maintain a state or local government owned public hospital system to provide care to these patients. However, New Jersey does not have a public hospital system and instead requires all hospitals to provide charitable care.

According to N.J.S.A. 26:2H-18.64, every acute care hospital in the state is required to provide care to any patient regardless of his or her ability to pay. Because hospitals cannot afford to provide services to the state's uninsured without financial assistance, the charity care program was established in 1993. The subsidy program was put in place to compensate hospitals for at least some portion of their costs of treating the uninsured.

New Jersey residents with incomes 300% of the Federal poverty level or below who do not qualify for Medicaid or any other insurance are eligible to receive charity care services for both inpatient and outpatient care at any of the state's acute care hospitals. Families with incomes up to 200% of the federal poverty level are eligible to receive free care, whereas families between 200-300% of the federal poverty level are responsible for a portion of their hospital bill. The following is an example of the Schedule of Discounted Amounts for Charity Care Patients:

Further, to qualify for charity care, individual assets cannot exceed \$7,500 and family assets cannot exceed \$15,000. Should an applicant's assets exceed these limits, a patient may "spend down" the assets to the eligible limits through payment of the excess toward the hospital bill and other approved out-of-pocket medical expenses.

Data Included in this Report

This report is based on data collected from 71 licensed New Jersey acute care hospitals for calendar year ending in 2018. Hospitals not included in this report include state-owned psychiatric hospitals, comprehensive rehabilitation hospitals, ambulatory surgery facilities, and federal military and veterans' hospitals.

The report is for CY 2018 (January 1, 2018 to December 31, 2018) and includes historical data from CY 2012 – 2017.

Hospital data is gathered from billing data that is submitted by the hospitals representing patient claims submitted to the state for CY 2018 through February 2019. Inpatient claim counts (discharges) are captured in our analysis. Outpatient claims counts are not reported because the occasions of service are largely incomparable.

Lack of National Charity Care Data for Comparison

This report compares DCC for the state between the years of 2012 and 2018. The report does not include charity care for New Jersey compared to national data.

There is no national requirement or data source for hospital charity care. In 1986, Congress enacted the Emergency Medical Treatment and Labor Act (EMTALA) so anyone can receive emergency services regardless of ability to pay (https://www.cms.gov/Regulations-and-Guidance/Legislation/EMTALA/index.html). New Jersey's charity care law is much broader than EMTALA and requires hospitals to provide medically necessary inpatient and outpatient services regardless of ability to pay.

Nationally, comparable data is available for uncompensated care, which includes both bad debt and charity care (https://www.aha.org/system/files/2019-01/uncompensated-care-fact-sheet-jan-2019.pdf). The American Hospital Association defines uncompensated care as an overall measure of care where no payment was received from the patient or insurer. This data is not comparable to the NJ hospital documented charity care primarily because the national data includes bad debt.

The State of New Jersey Documented Charity Care Data


Documented Charity Care increased gradually year over year until Statewide it peaked at \$1.03 billion in CY 2010 with a near peak in CY 2013 of \$1.02 billion (Table 3). Since CY 2010, significant decreases in DCC began in CY 2014 to \$570.2 million and continued to \$479.6 million in CY 2015. This rate of decrease slowed in CY 2016 to \$450.6 million, associated with the Medicaid expansion in New Jersey which began in 2014. This demonstrates relative stasis over the years between CY 2012 and 2013, followed by a significant decline in CY 2014, followed by a more tempered decline in CY 2015 and CY 2016. CY 2017 marked a trend

reversal as DCC increased possibly due to the federal rollback of Medicaid expansion and the Affordable Care Act.

Below is a chart that provides an overview of the seven-year trend in Documented Charity Care for all acute care hospitals.

The state-wide seven-year trend beginning in calendar year 2012 reveals a decrease of approximately \$510.2 million (51.1%) in DCC, with a peak of \$1.02 billion in CY 2013. CY 2018 results indicate that DCC increased statewide by \$5.8 million (1.3%) to \$487.4 million.

The seven-year trend demonstrates some variability, up and down, for individual hospitals and regions that could be attributable to a number of market and social forces.



Thirteen hospitals accounted for 61.8% of all DCC statewide. University Hospital reported the highest dollar amount of DCC in CY 2018 of \$61.1 million and accounted for 12.5% of total DCC for the state. Thirty-nine hospitals reported an increase in DCC from CY 2017, with total increases ranging from \$4.9 million to \$14,458. The remaining thirty-two hospitals reported a decrease in DCC. CarePoint Health – Christ Hospital reported the largest dollar decrease in CY 2018 of \$2.3 million. Raritain Bay Medical Center – Old Bridge reported the largest percentage decrease of 60.2%. Hackensack UMC – Pascack Valley reported the next largest percentage decrease in CY 2018 of \$219,050 to a high of \$61.1 million. Noting again that one closed hospital (Virtua – Berlin) reported a trickle of claim activity (\$7,411) in CY 2018 and is necessarily included in the DCC totals, though it is not included as appropriate in the analysis.

On January 1, 2014, the eligibility for NJ FamilyCare (Medicaid) was expanded to cover individuals with income up to 133% of the federal poverty level. The expansion of NJ FamilyCare made free or low-cost health coverage available to this newly eligible population, regardless of disability, family

status, or financial resources. These elements had previously been taken into account in Medicaid eligibility decisions. Since NJ residents with incomes up to 300% of the federal poverty level who do not qualify for Medicaid are eligible to receive charity care, there are patients that previously could have been included in the charity care program (included in DCC) that are now enrolled in Medicaid. The direct effect of NJ FamilyCare expansion on DCC cannot be quantified, but a large part of the decline in Charity Care between CY 2013 and CY 2014, and the continued decrease through CY 2016, is most likely due to NJ FamilyCare expansion. The trend reversal demonstrated in CY 2017 and continuing in CY 2018 DCC may be related to changes in federal policy related to the Affordable Care Act (ACA) beginning in 2017.

The following charts and analysis summarize data for DCC based on the Medicaid rate for all eligible New Jersey hospitals for each facility's calendar year ending in 2018 – 71 hospitals in total. New Jersey hospitals reported \$487.4 million in DCC in CY 2018. Total DCC increased 1.2% from CY 2017.

Documented Charity Care by Health System

RWJBarnabas Health reported the highest dollar amount of DCC for a health system in CY 2018 (Table 2) of \$79.8 million and accounted for 16.4% of total DCC for the state, with Hackensack Meridan Health reporting the second highest of \$54.3 million and 11.1% of the DCC statewide. RWJBarnabas Health reported the largest dollar increase of charity care for a health system in CY 2018 of \$4.1 million. Trinity Health reported the highest dollar decrease of DCC in CY 2018 for a health system of \$2.9 million or 31.0% from a CY 2017 total of \$12.0 million. Health systems reporting an increase and a decrease in DCC were evenly split with six each. Prime Healthcare reported the smallest dollar decrease in DCC in CY 2018 of \$736,362 or 3.2%. It is noteworthy that the highest dollar increase of charity care overall is due to all other hospitals combined who are not system affiliated for a total increase of \$6.0 million.

Health systems identified in this report correspond to the system membership as of December 31, 2018 for all time periods reported. RWJBarnabas and Hackensack Meridian Health System mergers are now reflected on a consolidated basis in this report.



Historical Documented Charity Care by County

The DCC was broken down by County (Table 3) for analysis. Essex County reported \$101.1 million in documented charity care in CY 2018 and is consistently the highest DCC county statewide. This one county accounted for 20.7% of all NJ DCC in CY 2018. Wide variation was seen in DCC among counties ranging from \$430,728 to \$101.1 million, with all counties, except for Atlantic, Cape May, Cumberland, Hudson, Hunterdon, Middlesex, Monmouth, Salem, and Sussex counties, experiencing an increase in DCC. Sussex County reported the lowest dollar amount of DCC in CY 2018 of \$430,728, accounting for only 0.1% of total DCC for the state.

Significant Changes in DCC between CY 2018, CY 2017, and CY 2016

The trend reversal in CY 2018 DCC as compared to CY 2017 through 2016, demonstrated thirty-nine hospitals had increases in their CY 2018 DCC, of which seventeen reversed their downward trend and demonstrated an increase in DCC between CY 2018 and CY 2017. Thirty-two hospitals demonstrated a decrease in DCC, of which eighteen reversed their upward trend and demonstrated a decrease in DCC between CY 2018 and CY 2017 and fourteen hospitals continued their declining trend from CY 2016.

DCC Inpatient and Outpatient Components

The statewide breakdown of 2018 DCC between Inpatient and Outpatient services returned to the general industry trend of migration from inpatient to outpatient services since CY 2012. The Inpatient portion of Statewide DCC has been generally declining from 54.4% to 51.7% for CY 2018, except for a significant trend reversal in CY 2016 to 49.8% and a minor trend reversal in CY 2014. Similarly, the statewide Outpatient portion of DCC has been generally increasing from 45.6% to 48.3% for CY 2018, except for a matching significant trend reversal in CY 2016 to 50.2%. CY 2016 DCC was the first-year outpatient services eclipsed inpatient services, but CY 2017 and 2018 DCC revert back to dominance of inpatient services. Wide variation, however, was seen in the split between Inpatient and Outpatient DCC amongst individual hospitals, ranging from Inpatient of 15.4% to 88.1% and Outpatient of 11.9% to 84.6%.

Conclusion

Overall, New Jersey hospitals reported \$487.4 million, Inpatient (51.7% or \$251.8 million) and Outpatient (48.3% or \$235.6 million), from 71 hospitals in DCC for CY 2018. Total DCC increased by

a total of \$5.8 million (1.2%) from CY 2017. These increases may be related to changes in federal policy related to the Affordable Care Act (ACA) beginning in 2017. Wide variation was seen in DCC among hospitals ranging from \$219,050 to \$61.1 million. At the county level Essex County reported \$101.1 million in documented charity care in CY 2018 and is consistently the highest DCC county statewide (20.7% of total DCC), and also reported the greatest increase in DCC of \$3.1 million. Middlesex County had the greatest decrease in DCC of \$4.7 million (9.0%), and Salem County experienced the smallest decrease in DCC of \$123,611 (15.1%). At the hospital system level, RWJBarnabas Health reported the highest dollar amount of DCC for a health system in CY 2018 (Table 2) of \$79.8 million (16.4% of total DCC). RWJBarnabas also reported the largest dollar increase of charity care for a health system in CY 2018 of \$4.1 million (5.1% increase over CY 2017). Trinity Health reported the highest dollar decrease of DCC in CY 2018 for a health system of \$2.9 million (31.0%). Health systems reporting an increase and a decrease in DCC were evenly split.
