





Summary of Findings:

Figure 1: Passaic county has more musculoskeletal and gastrointestinal, while fewer genitourinary birth defects compared to state average.

Figure 2: Black and Hispanic children have the highest rates of genitourinary conditions.

Figure 3: Older mothers (35+) are more likely to have children with chromosomal, gastrointestinal, cardiovascular and orofacial abnormalities.
