

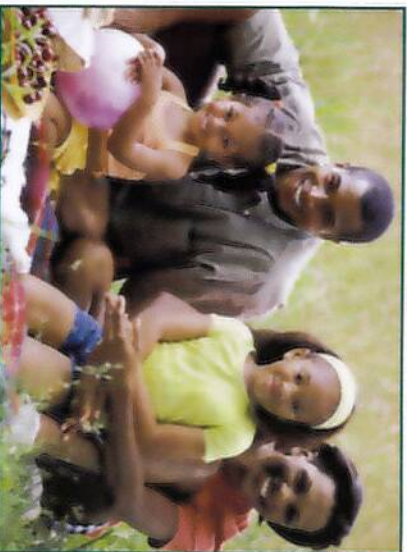
## Child Evaluation Centers

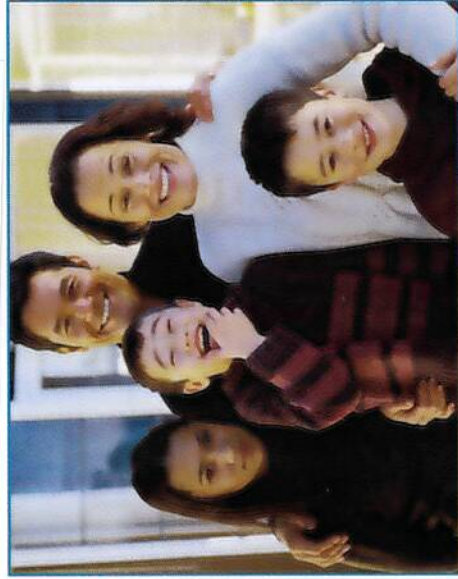
