




Alcohol Use by Passaic County IDRC Clients Compared with 2003 NJ Household Survey




Frequency of Alcohol Use by Passaic County Clients Compared with 2003 NJ Household Survey




Number of Alcohol-Related Offenses on DMV Records of Passaic County IDRC Clients



Lifetime Marijuana, Cocaine and Heroin Use by Passaic County IDRC Clients Compared with 2003 NJ Household Survey





<sup>\*</sup> RIASI Screening Score (Research Institute on Addictions Self Inventory): A DUI offender screening instrument created for and used by the State of New York in its Stop DWI Programs. Included are 41 True/False questions and 8 multiple response questions, each worth 1 point each. The questions cover several factors of substance dependence: classic symptoms, family history, risk-taking behavior, psychological factors, interpersonal competence, health, and alcohol beliefs. It was considered a positive screen if the client scores a 9 or above.
