




What was their **NATIONALITY**?

The leading cause of deaths was FALLS Total=108



Average Fell from 7% worked in heights of age was warehouses 42 yrs old 3 ft to 90 ft Victims with 19% fell at fatal head a residential injuries construction site included those who fell from same level or from low 6% fell through unguarded heights construction openings such as a stairwell, chimney, or elevator shaft
