- If you believe your privacy rights have been violated, you may file a complaint. Complaints must be filed in writing within 180 days of when the problem happened. There are a few ways to do this.

3. You can complain at any time to the federal Office of Civil Rights by calling 866-627-7748.

If you make a complaint to the Department of Human Services' Privacy Officer or to the Secretary of Health and Human Services, there will be no retaliation against you and your benefits will not be affected.
