DIVISION OF FAMILY DEVELOPMENT CURRENT PROGRAM STATISTICS DECEMBER 2013

Each month the Division of Family Development publishes its program statistics for: WFNJ/TANF, NJ SNAP, Emergency Assistance, General Assistance, and Child Support Services. When possible, information is provided separately for children and adults. Many tables also provide trend data with information broken down by county for readers to consider. This report is compiled and prepared by The Bureau of Research & Reporting.

WFNJ/TANF

- As of the end of December, the TANF caseload had decreased by 4,672 cases, from 39,334 in December 2012 to 34,662 in December 2013, a decrease of 11.9%.
- The counties with caseloads that decreased the most since December 2012 were Camden (-18.9%), Passaic (-20.3%), and Sussex (-23.8%).
- Of the WFNJ/TANF cases, 7,813 or 22.5% were child-only in December 2013.
- The counties with the most child-only cases were Essex (1,233), Camden (1,043), and Hudson (970).
- Essex (19,065), Passaic (10,362), Hudson (10,056), Camden (9,161) and Atlantic (5,434) counties had the greatest number of persons receiving TANF in December 2013.

NJ SNAP (formerly FOOD STAMPS)

- In December 2013, there were 429,927 households receiving NJ SNAP benefits. The number of NJ SNAP households decreased by 1,228, or 0.3%, since December 2012.
- There were 861,925 persons receiving NJ SNAP benefits as of December 2013, a decrease of 11,604 or 1.3% since December 2012.
- The three counties having the highest caseload increase since December 2012 are Salem (8.4%), Ocean (5.6%), and Gloucester (5.5%).

EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE

- There were 6,529 families receiving Emergency Assistance (EA) in December 2013, an increase of 111 or 1.7% since December 2012.
- In December 2013, EA payments were made for 1,847 SSI recipients.

GENERAL ASSISTANCE

GA Emergency Assistance

- There were 5,051 Emergency Assistance payments made to GA cases in December 2013, a decrease of 1,139 or 18.4% since December 2012.
- The three counties that show an annual percent increase in emergency assistance payments are Burlington (66.0%), Atlantic (22.4%), and Middlesex (12.2%).

GA Program

- The total numbers of cases receiving GA has decreased from 40,033 to 33,192 since December 2012, a decrease of 17.1%.
- There were 20,809 Employable GA and 12,383 Unemployable GA cases in December 2013.
- Warren (15.4%) and Middlesex (3.5%) counties showed the highest percent increase for GA cases since December 2012.
- In December 2013, GA cases showed a 1.0 percent decrease since November 2013.

CHILD SUPPORT SERVICES (Quarterly Report)

- The total collection for the Child Support Services Program was about \$316 million from October 2013 to December 2013, an increase of 0.1 percent over the same period for FFY 2013.
- Total distributions increased 2.2% from December 2012.


WORK FIRST NEW JERSEY (WFNJ)

- During the report month of December 2013, there were 4,020 families in which at least one member was employed and an additional 551 families whose WFNJ assistance cases were closed due to employment related earnings.
- The three counties with the greatest number of employed active WFNJ recipients were: Essex (958), Hudson (468), and Camden (434).
- There were 3,750 former TANF cases receiving post-TANF support in the form of child care assistance.





Work Participation Rates Achieved Over 12 Month Period Ending With DECEMBER 2013










ACRONYMS

CASS: Consolidated Assistance and Support System

EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE (EA) - Payments to those eligible for WFNJ/TANF or WFNJ/GA, authorized during the 30 consecutive days immediately following the emergency (defined as a substantial loss of shelter, food, clothing, or household furnishings by fire, flood or other similar disaster) or if eligible individual or family is an imminent or actual state of homelessness.

NJ SNAP - Formerly the Food Stamp Program, now known as **NJ SNAP** (NJ Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program) authorized by Congress as a nutritional supplement program to provide low income households with more food of greater variety and better nutrition. Program eligibility is based on household income, resources, and expenses for medical, shelter, and dependent care. CWA staff refers certain recipients to the New Jersey Department of Labor for participation in the Food Stamp Employment and Training Program.

FAMIS: Family Assistance Management Information System

GAAS: General Assistance Automated System

NJKiDS: New Jersey Kids Deserve Support (Child Support Information Management System)

NJ MMIS SHARED DATA WAREHOUSE: The Shared Data Warehouse (SDW) is the repository for New Jersey's DFD and Medicaid data. Since 2003, OptumInsight has administered the SDW and provided access to the data through a reporting tool known as Business Objects.

OMEGA: Online Management of Economic Goal Achievement

SSI-EA: Supplemental Security Income-Emergency Assistance

WFNJ: Work First New Jersey - Fully implemented July 1, 1997, this is New Jersey's welfare reform program which responds to the requirements of the Federal Personal Responsibility and Work Opportunity Reconciliation Act (PRWORA) of 1996. PRWORA established Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) as the replacement for AFDC cash assistance. WFNJ includes two segments, WFNJ/TANF for families with children, and WFNJ/GA (General Assistance) for single adults and couples without dependent children. WFNJ emphasizes achieving self-sufficiency and limits lifetime receipt of financial assistance to a total of five years.
