As Director of the Division of Medical Assistance and Health Services, I have reviewed the record in this case, including the OAL case file and the Initial Decision approving the Settlement Agreement reached by the parties. Procedurally, the time period for the Agency Head to file a Final Decision is November 3, 2017, in accordance with N.J.S.A. 52:14B-10 which requires an Agency Head to adopt, reject, or modify the Initial Decision within 45 days of receipt. The Initial Decision was received on September 19, 2017.

This matter arises from the termination of Petitioner's Medicaid benefits based on his failure to execute the annual written redetermination application. The parties entered into a settlement on the record whereby the parties agreed that the August 1, 2017 termination letter was moot because Petitioner subsequently provided an application. That application was denied due to excess resources. However, the parties agreed that Petitioner would provide additional financial documentation and the Respondent would reprocess the documentation and issue a new determination letter. By Initial Decision dated September 18, 2017, the ALJ approved the Settlement Agreement because it was consistent with the law, fully disposed of all issues in controversy and was voluntarily entered into by both parties in accordance with N.J.A.C. 1:11-19.1.

Based on my review of the record, I concur with the ALJ's findings and hereby ADOPT the Settlement Agreement.

THEREFORE, it is on this Hay of OCTOBER 2017,

ORDERED:

That the Initial Decision affirming the Settlement Agreement in this matter is hereby ADOPTED.
