FINAL AGENCY DECISION

OAL DKT. NO. HMA 02584-17

As Director of the Division of Medical Assistance and Health Services, I have reviewed the record in this matter, consisting of the Initial Decision, the documents in evidence and the contents of the OAL case file. No exceptions to the Initial Decision were filed. Procedurally, the time period for the Agency Head to render a Final Agency Decision is June 26, 2017 in accordance with N.J.S.A. 52:14B-10, which requires an Agency Head to adopt, reject, or modify the Initial Decision within 45 days of the agency's receipt. The Initial Decision was received on May 10, 2017.


Based upon my review of the record, I hereby ADOPT the findings, conclusions and recommended decision of the Administrative Law Judge in their

entirety and incorporate the same herein by reference. I agree with the Administrative Law Judge that the credible evidence in this record indicates that Petitioner does not satisfy the eligibility criteria necessary to qualify for Personal Care Assistant (PCA) services pursuant to N.J.A.C. 10:60-3.1 et seq. I note that Petitioner may reapply for PCA services if there is a change in her condition.

THEREFORE, it is on this ^{9th} day of June 2017,

ORDERED:

That the Initial Decision affirming the denial of continued PCA services is hereby ADOPTED as the Final Decision in this matter.
