As Director of the Division of Medical Assistance and Health Services, I have reviewed the record in this case, including the Initial Decision and the documents in evidence. Neither party filed exceptions. Procedurally, the time period for the Agency Head to file a Final Agency Decision in this matter is July 17, 2017 in accordance with N.J.S.A. 52:14B-10 which requires an Agency Head

to adopt, reject or modify the Initial Decision within 45 days of receipt. The Initial Decision in this matter was received on June 2, 2017.

This appeal stems from Passaic County's denial of Medicaid eligibility because Petitioner's income exceeded the eligibility standards. However, at the scheduled OAL hearing, the parties entered into a settlement on the record whereby Petitioner provided additional evidence of her income and Passaic County agreed to reevaluate Petitioner's eligibility. The ALJ approved the Settlement Agreement because it was consistent with the law, fully disposed of all issues in controversy and was voluntarily entered into by both parties, in accordance with N.J.A.C. 1:1-19.1.

Based on my review of the record, I concur with the ALJ's findings and hereby ADOPT the Settlement Agreement.

THEREFORE, it is on this ^{23rd} day of JUNE 2017,

ORDERED:

That the Initial Decision affirming the terms of the Settlement in this matter is hereby ADOPTED.
