As Assistant Commissioner of the Division of Medical Assistance and Health Services (DMAHS), I have reviewed the record in this case, including the OAL case file, the Settlement Agreement and the Initial Decision in this matter. No exceptions were filed. Procedurally, the time period for the Agency Head to file a Final Decision is May 11, 2020, in accordance with an Order of Extension.

This matter concerns an investigation conducted by the Office of the State Comptroller; Medicaid Fraud Division (MFD) of Petitioner's billing practices. As a result of

the investigation, MFD issued a Notice of Claim, Notice of Withhold and a Certificate of Debt. By way of settlement the parties agreed to resolve the matter as set forth in the agreement.


The ALJ approved the Settlement Agreement because it was consistent with the law, fully disposed of all issues in controversy and was voluntarily entered into by both parties, in accordance with N.J.A.C. 1:1-19.1.

Based upon my review of the record, I agree with the ALJ's conclusions and ADOPT the Settlement Agreement as based upon substantial credible evidence and consistent with applicable law.

THEREFORE, it is on this 7th day of MAY 2020,

ORDERED:

That the Initial Decision approving the Settlement Agreement is hereby ADOPTED.
